Proposal Support Form

This form should be completed by the faculty member's department chair (or, in the case of Leadership Studies, Law, or Continuing and Professional Studies, the dean). For staff with faculty status, both the supervisor of the staff member AND the department chair of the course-sponsoring department must complete a form. If the course is a First-Year Seminar, the director of FYS will also verify that the FYS course has already been approved by the University Faculty Senate.

Faculty Commitment

Faculty who are approved to participate in The Richmond Endeavor will be required to: serve as the academic advisor to the sixteen students within their community from summer pre-matriculation until the students declare a major; participate in the Roadmap to Success pre-orientation program; teach a fall one-unit course in the fall semester; and lead a .5-unit project-based course in the spring semester.

Faculty are remunerated \$7,500 for their participation in The Richmond Endeavor. There is no course release associated with a faculty member's participation. Faculty members typically cannot participate in The Richmond Endeavor two years in a row, due to the advising load.
