## **Faculty Commitment**

Faculty with an approved renewal will teach their SSIR course for one or two years, as part of their normal teaching load. The teaching commitment is a one-unit course in the fall semester, and a half-unit course in the spring semester. Faculty will also participate in the recruitment and selection activities that take place in the spring semester prior to their teaching.

Faculty are remunerated \$7,500 for their participation in the Sophomore Scholars in Residence Program. There is no course release associated with a faculty member's renewal of their SSIR course.
