## **Proposal for a New SSIR Course: Support Form**

This form should be completed by the faculty member's department chair (or, in the case of Leadership Studies, Law, or Continuing and Professional Studies, the dean). For staff with faculty status, both the supervisor of the staff member AND the department chair of the course-sponsoring department must complete a form.

## **Faculty Commitment**

Faculty with an approved proposal will be required to engage in a year-long faculty learning community (meets monthly) during their planning year; teach a one-unit course in the fall semester, and a half-unit course in the spring semester. Faculty will also participate in the recruitment and selection activities that take place in the spring semester prior to their teaching.

Faculty are remunerated \$7,500 for their participation in the Sophomore Scholars in Residence Program. Faculty are also remunerated with a one-unit course reduction in their teaching load. This reduction can take place in either semester during their planning year, and should be done in consultation with the department chair or dean. The Sophomore Scholars in Residence program has funds available for adjunct replacement if needed.
